## Data Protection Declaration

### PRIVACY STATEMENT

#### § 1 INFORMATION ABOUT THE COLLECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

(1) In the following we inform you about the collection of personal data when using our website. Personal data is all data that can be related to you personally, e.g. name, address, e-mail addresses, user behavior.

(2) Responsible according to Art. 4 para. 7 EU Data Protection Basic Regulation (GDPR) is Alberto Diaz-Durana (see <https://hedera.online/index.html#team>).

(3) When you contact us by e-mail or via a contact form, the data provided by you (your valid e-mail address, if necessary if you want your name and telephone number) will be stored by us to answer your inquiries. The data processing for the purpose of the establishment of contact with us takes place on the basis of the art. 6 Abs. 1 S. 1 lit. a GDPR. The data arising in this connection will be deleted as soon as it is no longer required to be stored, or processing will be restricted if there are legal storage obligations.

#### § 2 COLLECTION OF PERSONAL DATA WHEN YOU VISIT OUR WEBSITE

(1) If you only use the website for information purposes, i.e. if you do not register or otherwise provide us with information, we only collect the personal data that your browser transmits to our server. If you wish to view our website, we collect the following data, which is technically necessary for us to display the website to you and to ensure convenient use of the website as well as stability, security and smooth connectivity (legal basis is Art. 6 Para. 1 S. 1 lit. f GDPR):

- IP address
- Date and time of the request
- Time zone difference to Greenwich Mean Time (GMT)
- Contents of the request (concrete page)
- Access status/HTTP status code
- amount of data transferred in each case
- Website from which the request originates
- browser
- Operating system and its interface u.
- Language and version of the browser software.

Our justified interest follows from the purposes listed above for the collection of data. Under no circumstances do we use the collected data for the purpose of drawing conclusions about you.

(2) In addition to the aforementioned data, cookies are stored on your computer when you use our website. Cookies are small text files that are stored on your hard drive assigned to the browser you are using and through which certain information flows to the location where the cookie is set. Cookies cannot execute programs or transmit viruses to your computer. They serve to make the website more user-friendly and effective.

(3) Use of cookies:

a) This website uses the following types of cookies, the scope and function of which are explained below:

- Transient Cookies (see b)
- Persistent cookies (see c)

b) Transient cookies are automatically deleted when you close your browser. These include in particular session cookies. They store a so-called session ID, which can be used to assign various requests from your browser to the shared session. This enables your computer to be recognized when you return to our website. The session cookies are deleted when you log out or close your browser.

c) Persistent cookies are automatically deleted after a specified period, which may vary depending on the cookie. You can delete cookies at any time in the security settings of your browser.

d) You can configure your browser settings according to your wishes and, for example, refuse to accept third-party cookies or all cookies. We would like to point out that you may not be able to use all the functions of this website.

### § 3 DISCLOSURE OF DATA

We will only pass on your personal data to third parties if:

- you have given your express consent to this in accordance with Art. 6 Para. 1 S. 1 lit. a GDPR
- the disclosure according to Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. f GDPR is necessary for the assertion, exercise or defense of legal claims and there is no reason to assume that you have an overriding legitimate interest in not disclosing your data,
- in the event that there is a legal obligation to pass on data in accordance with Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. c GDPR, and
- this is legally permissible and required for the execution of contractual relationships with you according to Art. 6 Para. 1 S. 1 lit. b GDPR.

Your personal data will not be transferred to third parties for purposes other than those listed below.

### § 4 YOUR RIGHTS

(1) You have the following rights towards us with regard to the personal data concerning you:

- Right of access,
- Right to rectification or deletion,
- Right to limit the processing,
- Right to object to the processing,
- Right to data transferability.

(2) You also have the right to complain to a data protection supervisory authority about the processing of your personal data by us.

### § 5 OBJECTION OR REVOCATION AGAINST THE PROCESSING OF YOUR DATA

(1) If you have given your consent to the processing of your data, you can revoke it at any time. Such a revocation influences the permissibility of the processing of your personal data after you have given it to us.

(2) Insofar as we base the processing of your personal data on a weighing of interests, you may object to the processing. This is the case if the processing is in particular not necessary for the fulfilment of a contract with you, which is described by us in the following description of the functions. In the event of such an objection, we ask you to explain the reasons why we should not process your personal data as we have done. In the event of your justified objection, we will examine the situation and either discontinue or adapt the data processing or point out our compelling reasons worthy of protection on the basis of which we will continue the processing.

(3) You may revoke the processing of your personal data for advertising and data analysis purposes at any time. You can inform us about your advertising objection under our contact data mentioned below.

### § 6 DATA SECURITY

We use state-of-the-art encryption technology supported by your browser during your visit to our website. You can tell whether an individual page of our website is transmitted in encrypted form by the closed representation of the key or lock symbol in the status bar of your browser. We also use appropriate technical and organizational security measures to protect your data against accidental or intentional manipulation, partial or complete loss, destruction or against unauthorized access by third parties. Our security measures are continuously improved in line with technological developments.

### § 7 GENERAL
